Each paper will be allocated approximately 20 minutes for presentation and discussion.

Student research papers should have a student as the single author. The paper should describe the topic, preliminary results, and future direction of the student's on-going research. The student must commit to present the paper at the conference.

Papers submitted to the Forum should be at most 4 pages in length and must be formatted using standard two-column IEEE format.
